

Proctorio is an automated remote proctoring service that uses computers to monitor student behavior. This is a one-time procedure to activate Proctorio for your Canvas course(s) via a Chrome extension. Proctorio requires Chrome as your browser. If you do not have Chrome, [install it first](#) on your computer.

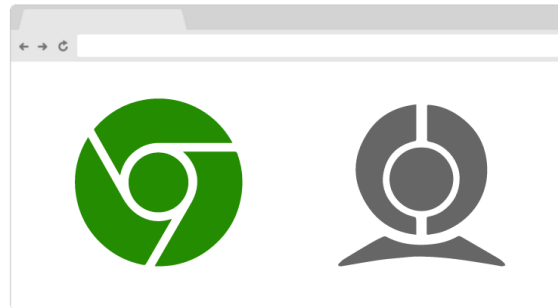

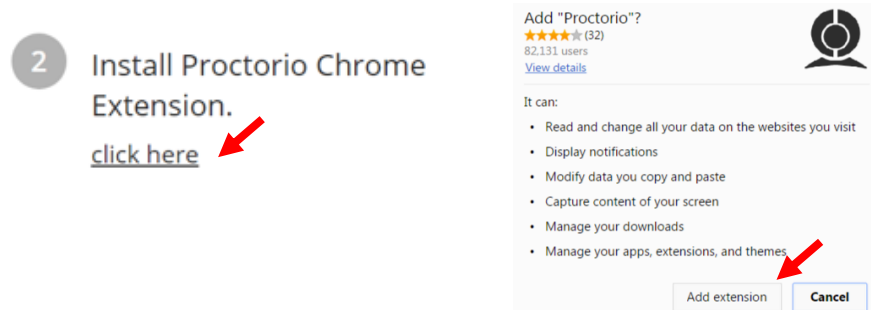
## Proctorio Chrome Extension

2. Under Step 2, click on the link, "[click here](#)" and then click the button, **Add extension**:



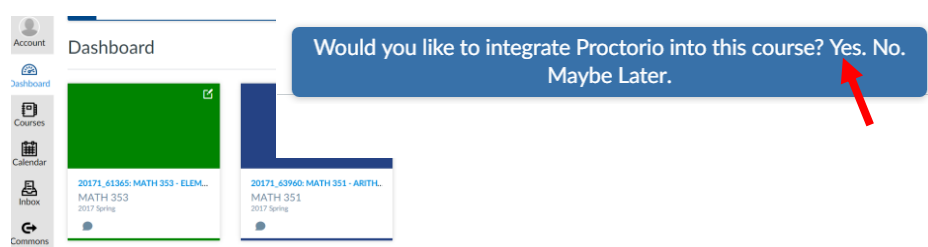

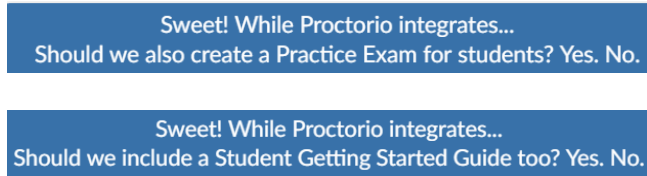

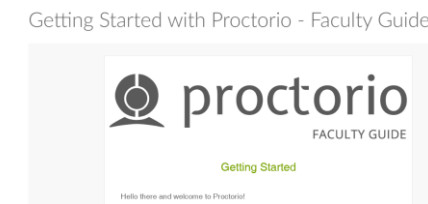
4. After logging into Canvas, select the course you want to add Proctorio to. You will then see the the prompt at the top of your course – click **Yes**:
