We are so glad you have decided to take an online course at Irvine Valley College. We want you to excel in the online environment, so we have created this online orientation to help prepare you for success!

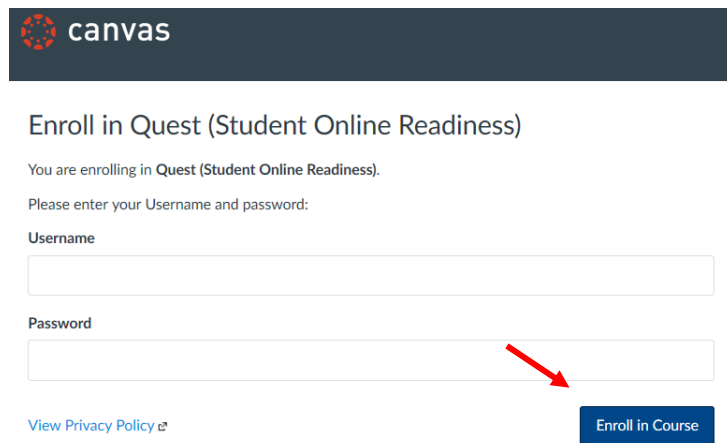

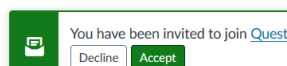
